The City has received a petition submitted by 8 resident owners of adjacent to Outlot C that was dedicated to the public by WINMAR Estates LLC planners in 1976 to preserve the area if ever needed to connect 64th Street to Ideal Ave.

Under consideration is whether the City should vacate the area, pursuant to MN Statute 412.851, which requires that 50% of the area would go to the ownership of the neighbor to the north, and 50% to the 8 undivided owners of Outlot C. to the South. The City is conducting a public hearing to receive input from the public.

The hearing will be held at 8PM CDT on Tuesday July 6, 2021.

Because of Covid-19 restrictions on public meetings, the hearing will be held by Zoom Teleconference.


